A LIVING BOTANICAL COLLECTION

Our garden spans 27 acres and is home to over 1700 plant species. This includes 720 of the 742 species documented in the 17th-century *Hortus Malabaricus*, a significant botanical work initiated by the Dutch Commander, Hendrik van Rheede. Our ongoing efforts include the propagation of endemic, endangered, and restricted-range plant species of the Western Ghats, contributing to plant conservation.

Stone Villa

The Pool Villa includes stone-crafted walls, a private pool, sit-out area, and a king-size bed. It comes with air conditioning, flat-screen TV, mini-fridge, tea and coffee maker, and Wi-Fi.



Deluxe Villa

The Deluxe Villa offers modern design, a king-size bed, and essential amenities like air conditioning, flat-screen TV, mini-fridge, tea and coffee maker, and Wi-Fi.



Birdwing Farmhouse

The Birdwing Farmhouse accommodates up to 8 guests with 4 bedrooms, each with a king-size bed and attached bathroom. Rooms open to a common lounge with a 64" TV, and Wi-Fi.

CURATED ON-SITE ACTIVITIES

Guests can engage in activities designed to connect them with the local environment and its history:

Guided Garden Tours: Led by naturalists, providing information on the garden's flora and historical context.

Bird Watching: Habitats to observe local bird species.

Butterfly Garden: A dedicated space to view various butterfly species.

Walking Trails: Paths for exploring the natural landscape within the property.





Nearby:

The Irunilamkode Rock-cut Temple: 9 km - (circa 8th-9th century CE temple dedicated to both Shaivite and Vaishnavite traditions)

Varikkassery Mana: 15 km - (shooting location of Devasuram, Aaraam Thampuran and other commercially successful malayalam theatre arts; paid visit ~ 100/ head)

Pazhayannur Bhagavathy Temple: 30 km - (Built by the Portuguese circa 1555 as a gift for the Naduvazhi of the princely state of Kochi, the temple still practices a unique tradition of live rooster offerings)

Chulanur Peafowl Sanctuary and butterfly park

Managed by Kerala Forest Department: 5 km ahead of destination item no. 3.

Feasibility of all temple visits for inbound western travellers to be checked with temple authorities.

INTEGRATING KERALA'S CULTURAL HERITAGE:

Our location facilitates access to the performing arts and traditions of Kerala, offering an additional dimension to the guest experience:

Proximity to Kalamandalam University: We are situated near **Kerala Kalamandalam University**, a prominent institution for Indian performing arts.

Cultural Showcases: We can arrange for **Kutiyattom performances** (an ancient Sanskrit theatre form, recognized by UNESCO) to be experienced in the garden's setting, offering a glimpse into Kerala's classical traditions.

Local Cultural Experiences: Opportunities can be arranged for guests to observe or engage with other traditional art forms or interact with local artists.

Culinary Journey: Our on-site restaurant offers a serene dining experience with a **farm-to-table concept**, featuring fresh ingredients from our organic garden. We provide both traditional Kerala flavors and accommodate special dietary requests with advance notice.



FACILITIES & ACCESSIBILITY:

Convenient Transport: Buggy services within the resort, parking, and transport assistance.

Accessibility: Main pathways are wheelchair accessible.

Airport Transfers: Pre-arranged transfers from Cochin International Airport (85 km) or Calicut International Airport (100 km).

Rail Connectivity: Shornur Railway Station (6 km) offers convenient access.
